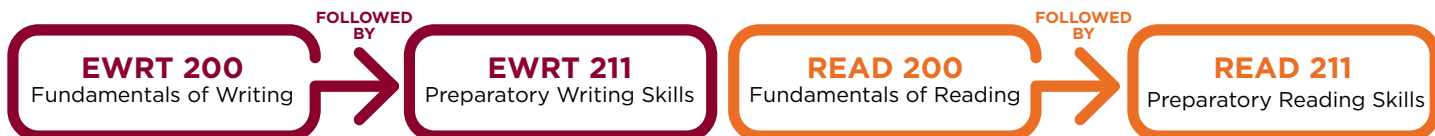

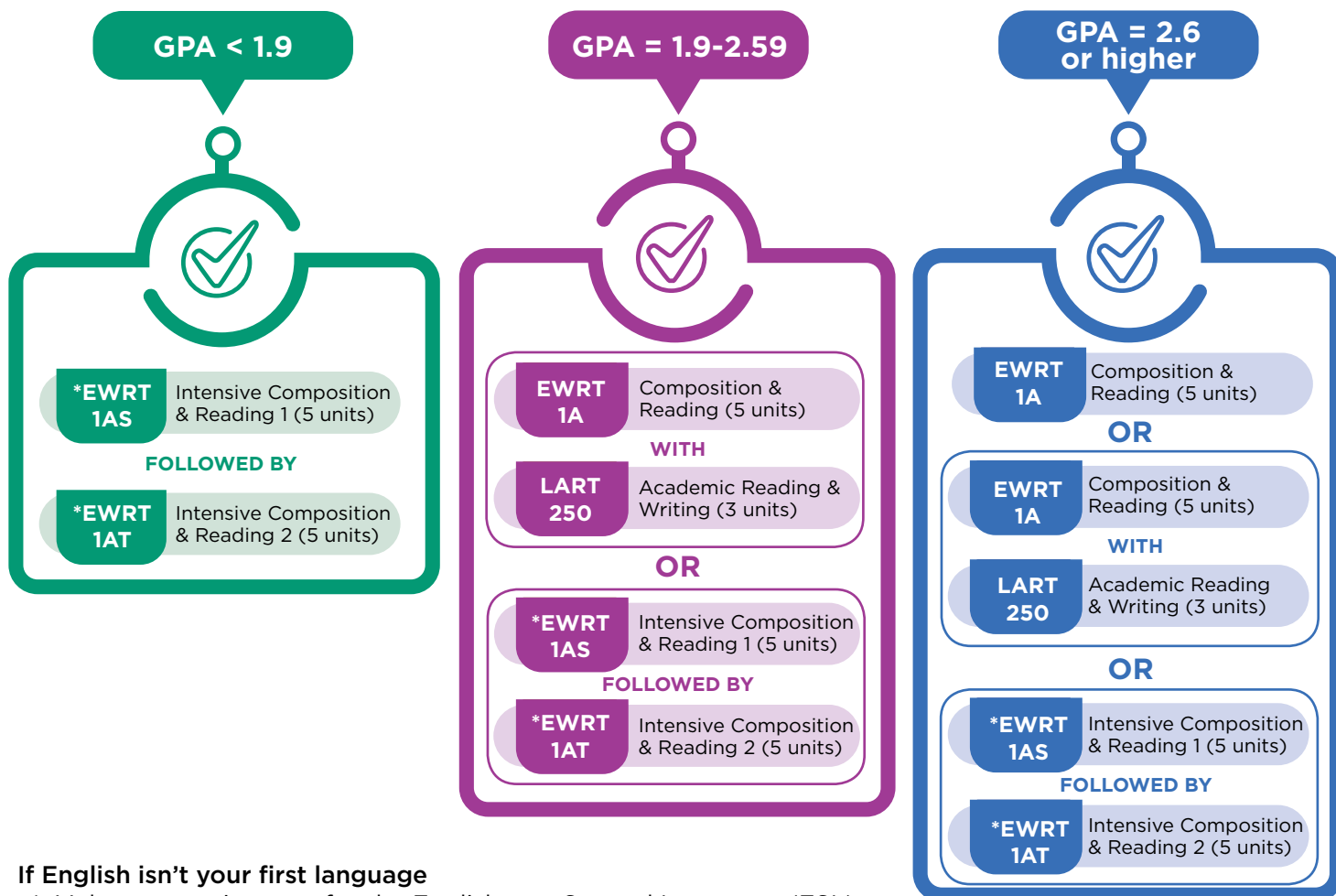
OPTIONAL COURSES
