### Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment

- Total resident and non-resident WSCH increased 1% from 274,455 to 277,870.
- Total resident and non-resident unduplicated headcount decreased 1% from 23,234 to 23,098.
- Resident WSCH is up 1% from 238,310 to 239,550, and non-resident WSCH is up 6% from 36,145 to 38,320.

### Student Type

- First-time student headcount increased 12% from 3,686 to 4,140 and FTES increased 13%.
- Returning student headcount increased 4% from 2,285 to 2,365 and FTES increased 4%.
- Continuing student headcount remained flat at 13,176 while FTES increased 2%.
- First-time transfer student headcount decreased 17% from 3,823 to 3,154 while FTES decreased 19%.

### Continuing Students by Ethnicity

Continuing student enrollment accounts for students who were enrolled in the spring and returned the fall quarter. These students are our largest proportion of enrollment each quarter and are a proxy for students who persist from quarter to quarter without dropping out. However, fall to spring enrollment does not account for students who transferred or received an award.

- African American continuing student headcount increased 8% from 473 to 509.
- Asian student continuing headcount increased 1% from 4,990 to 5,021.
- Latino/a student continuing headcount increased 8% from 3,011 to 3,248.

### Zip Code Groupings

- Enrollment from Cupertino, Sunnyvale, Los Altos, Mountain View, Palo Alto, Los Gatos and Saratoga decreased 2.2% from 4,878 to 4,768.
- Enrollment from San Jose East of 880, Alviso, Milpitas, Fremont, Union City, Newark, Hayward and East Palo Alto decreased 1.42% from 11,389 to 11,227. Enrollment from All Other Areas increased 18.43% from 1,644 to 1,947.

- As a percent of the total enrolled population, students from the Cupertino group remained flat at 21% while students from the San Jose East of 880 group remained flat as well at 49%.
- San Jose Other decreased 1% from 22% to 21% while All Other Areas increased 1%.

### Application Data

- 34% of new registrants reported that they participated in community activities from once a week to once a month in the past year.
- 57% of applicants reported their family income to be \$50,000 or less per year.
- 38% of applicants reported they speak a language other than English at home, this is down from 40% the prior fall.
- The top languages spoken by students includes: Spanish, Vietnamese, Chinese, Korean, Cantonese, Farsi, Tagalog, Mandarin, Hindi, Punjabi and Filipino.
