SUBJECT: Nursing Program Clinical Survey, Fall 2015

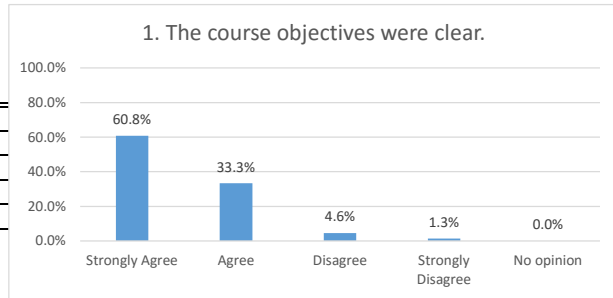
A survey was sent by faculty to students of De Anza College enrolled in the Nursing Program during the Fall quarter 2015. A total of 154 students responded to the online survey.

Important highlights include:

- 99% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the amount of work required for this course was appropriate for the credit received. (Question 3)
- 84% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the assigned reading and A.V.s for this course were appropriate. (Question 8)
- 95% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the objectives of the course were obtainable. (Question 2)
- 94% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the course objectives were clear. (Question 1)
- 93% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the out-of-class suggested reading and A.V. assignments were accessible. (Question 7)
- 92% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the required textbook for this course was helpful for meeting the objectives. (Question 5)
- 90% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the complexity of the course was appropriate for this level. (Question 4)
- 86% of respondents “agree” or “strongly agree” that the out-of-class assignments (e.g., A.V., group activities, etc.) were relevant to the course objectives. (Question 6)

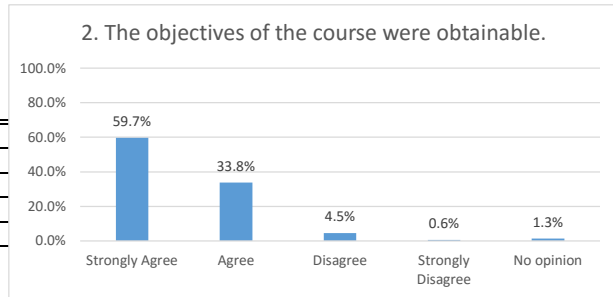

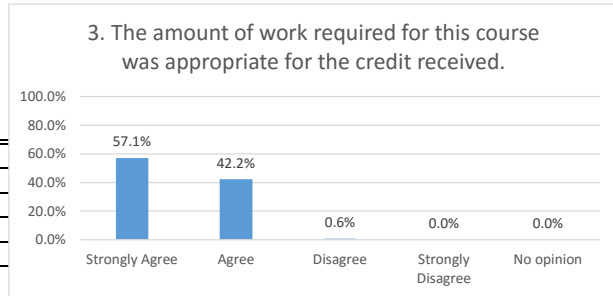

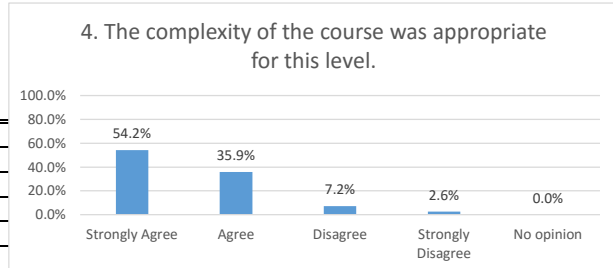

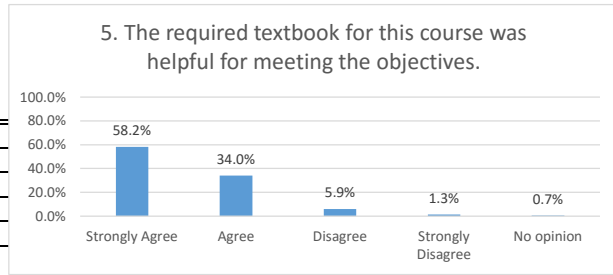

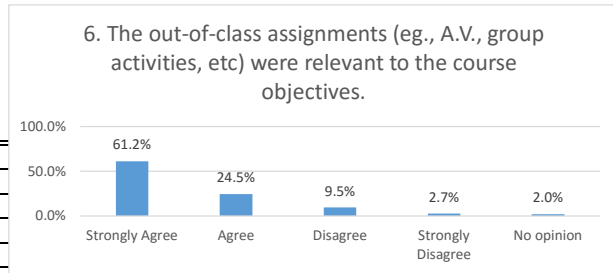

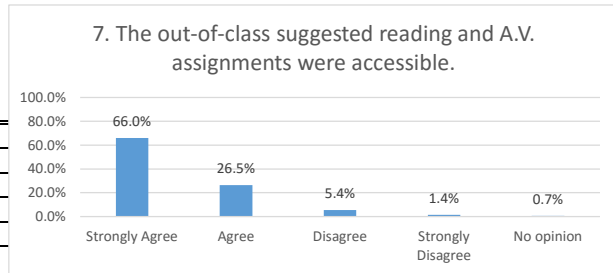

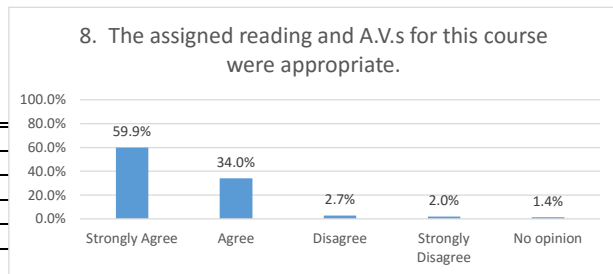
