From winter 2011 to winter 2012:

Resident and Non-Resident Enrollment

- Total resident and non-resident WSCH is up 1% at 263,514.
- Total resident and non-resident unduplicated headcount is down 1% at 21,763.
- Resident WSCH is up 1% at 230,471.
- Non-resident WSCH is up 1% at 33,043.

From winter 2011 (end of term) to winter 2012 (census):

Student Status

- First-time student headcount decreased 13% from 587 to 508.
- First-time transfer student headcount decreased 19% from 1,720 to 1,393.
- Continuing student headcount increased 2% from 16,523 to 16,855.

District of Residence

- Enrollment of students from the De Anza service area decreased 7% from 4,582 to 4,269
- Enrollment of students from the San Jose-Evergreen area increased 6% from 5,859 to 6,187.

International Students

- International students with F1 visa status increased 4% from 1,611 to 1,671.

Ethnicity – A new methodology for calculating ethnicity was implemented in winter 2012.

Multi-ethnic is no longer reported.

- Hispanic enrollment increased 61% from 2,620 to 4,220.
- Unrecorded enrollment decreased 32% from 2,465 to 1,670.

From winter 2011 to winter 2012:

Distance Learning

- Total distance learning estimated WSCH is down 15% at 18,899.
- Distance learning headcount is down 11% from 3,640 to 3,244.
- Distance learning course enrollment is down 18% from 5,493 to 4,486.
- Distance learning sections offered is up 6% from 133 to 141 but the enrollment went down suggesting that on average, fewer students are enrolled in each section.
